 Acceptance Procedures for students from **The Arab Countries**
 (who have official school report cards)

Before coming to Jordan	
First:	From the following authorities, obtain an officially stamped/signed School Report Card for the current school year:
	The school in which the student enrolled
	The Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education in your country
	The Jordanian Embassy in your country
After coming to Jordan	
Second:	Official stamp on the School Report Card from your Embassy in Jordan
Third	Official stamp on the School Report Card from the Jordanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs
fourth:	Bring the above to the Baptist School, at which time, the student will be given an Acceptance Sheet from the school in the specified class level.
Fifth:	<p>Go to the Directorate of Private Schools / Examinations Dept./ taking with you the following papers – to get a Permanent Acceptance for the student in the Baptist School.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The school report card 2. - Valid Residence Permit for the foreign student (stamped on the passport) - Valid Residence Permit for the Arab student that needs residence in Jordan - Entrance Stamp Visa on the passport for the Arab student whose coming from the Arab countries who are not required to have residence in Jordan - Valid work permission in Jordan for the student's father who is coming from (Saudi Arabia / Egypt / Yemen) 3. The Acceptance Sheet from the Baptist School 4. The Equalizing Report from the Ministry of Education. <p>Directorate address: Jabal Al Hussein / behind Al Hussein Police Station / Beside Al Ma'mounieh circle. Sixth:	Bring the Permanent Acceptance paper from the Directorate of Private Schools to the Baptist School.
